Recommencement of Operations on No. 3 Crude Distillation Unit of Nippon Petroleum Refining Company, Limited's Mizushima Refinery

Nippon Oil Corporation (NOC, Fumiaki Watari, President)'s subsidiary Nippon Petroleum Refining Company, Limited, has announced that, having obtained safety confirmation from the relevant authorities, its Mizushima Refinery (Kurashiki City, Okayama Prefecture; Hiroshi Ohno, Refinery Chief) will recommence operations today (August 13, 2003) on its No. 3 crude distillation unit (crude oil processing capacity, 140,000 BD). The unit was temporarily shutdown following a fire outbreak on August 5, 2003.

Furthermore, although NOC's Marifu and Osaka Refineries were shutdown on August 4, 2003, NOC will increase capacity utilization rates of its Mizushima and other refineries and also take such measures as purchasing petroleum products on the market, using up inventories, reducing exports, increasing petroleum product imports, and commissioned refining to compensate for the decline in production resulting from these shutdown, and NOC foresees no disruption in supply.
